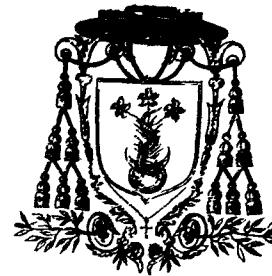

(b) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full, and present address.
(c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW, the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND—not of the applicant herself.
(d) State whether a British-born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.
(e) State whether proceeding; and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports), e.g., accompanied by his wife A. and children B. and C., with their Tutor, D. E., and a Governess, F. G., and Maid Servant, H. K., and Men Servant, L. M. (all British Subjects).
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.
In the case of persons proceeding to RUSSIA, the ages of children should be stated; and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz:—
Resident British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be), giving professional or business address.
Recommendations from Banking Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
