 - (w) In the case of a **MARRIED WOMAN** OR **WIDOW**, the particulars of birth required are those of her **HUSBAND** OR **LATE HUSBAND** -- not of the applicant herself.
 - (x) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.
 - (y) State whether proceeding; and names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports), e.g., accompanied by his wife A. and children B. and C., with their Tutor, D. E., and a Governor, F. G., and Maid Servant, H. K., and Men Servant, L. M. (all British Subjects).
 - (z) The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.
 - (aa) In the case of persons proceeding to Russia, the place of children should be stated; and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.

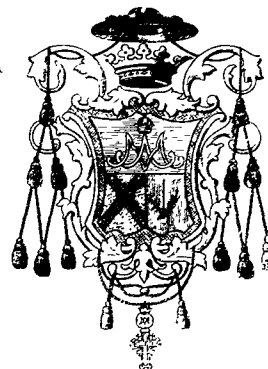
