- (c) In the case of a **MARRIED WOMAN** OR **WIDOW**, the particulars of birth required are those of her **HUSBAND** OR **LATE HUSBAND** — not of the applicant herself.
- (d) State whether a **British born Subject** or a **naturalized British Subject**. **IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.**
- (e) State whether proceeding; and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports), *e.g., as accompanied by his wife A. and children D. and C., with their Tutor, D. E. & a Governess, F. G., and Maid Servant, H. K., and Men Servant, L. M. (all British Subjects).*
- The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.
- In the case of persons proceeding to **RUSSIA**, the ages of children should be stated; and the religion of the applicant will be presumed in the absence of evidence to be that of a **British subject** or other satisfied evidence.
- (f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a **MARK** should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz. —
Resident British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be), giving Professional or business address.
- (h) The names of persons, **Religious Forms** should bear the printed name of the Rank.
