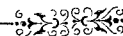

- (b) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full and present address.
- (c) In the case of a **MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW** the particulars of birth required are those of her **HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND**—not of the applicant herself
- (d) State whether a **British born Subject** or a **naturalized British Subject** IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
- (e) State whether proceeding *as a* **Member of a community** or **personally** whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) *e.g., accompanied by* **my wife I and my children D, E and C with their Tutor D, E and a Governor F G and Maid Servant H K and Men Servant L M (all all British Subjects)**
- The **Christian Name and Surname** of each person *not* to be given in full

- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration *viz*
Resident British Merchant Banker Minister of Religion Physician Surgeon Barrister or Professor (as the case may be) giving address and business address
