- The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
- In the case of persons proceeding to BRITAIN the religion of the children of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
- (j) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
- (k) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz—
Resident British Merchant Banker Minister of Religion 1735 can Surgeon Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving personal or business address
- Recommendations from Banking Firms should bear the printed name of the Bank.
