- (a) Insert name of Place and Date
- (b) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full and present address.
- (c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND — not of the applicant herself
- (d) State whether a British born Subject of a naturalized British Subject IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
- (e) State whether proceeding, and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) e.g. accompanied by *his wife A. and children B. and C. with their Tutor D. E. and a Governess F. G. and Miss-Servant H. K. and Men-Servant L. M. (all British Subjects)*
- The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
- (f) In the case of persons proceeding to Russia, the age of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the report on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
- (g) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
- (h) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz — *Resident British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor* (as the case may be) giving professional or business address
- Recommendations from *Banks, Friends* should bear the printed stamp of the T.M.K.
