- (c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND - not of the applicant herself
- (d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
- (g) State whether proceeding and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) e.g., accompanied by his wife and children B and C with their Tutor D E and a Governess F G and Maid Servant H K and Man Servant L M (all British Subjects)
- (h) The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
- (i) In the case of persons proceeding to RUSSIA the ages of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
- (j) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
- (k) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz - Resident British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address
- Recommendations from Bankers, Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank

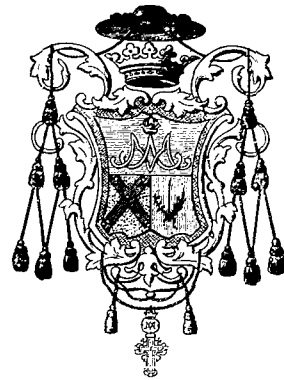
