(c) In the case of a MARKED WOMAN or WIDOW, the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND or LATE HUSBAND—not of the applicant herself.  
(d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.  
(e) State whether proceeding, and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports), *e.g.*, accompanied by *his wife A. and children B. C. and their Tutor, D. E., and a Governor, F. G., and Maid Servant, H. K. (all British Subjects)*.  
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.  
In the case of a child proceeding to SIGNIFY, the name of the child must be stated, and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.  
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.  
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz. *Resident British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor* (to the class may be added, giving professional or business address).  
Recommendations from *Banking Firms* should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
