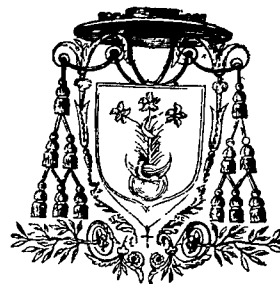

(e) State whether proceeding and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) e.g. accompanied by his wife A, his children B and C, with their Tutor D E, and a Governor F G and his Servant H K and Man Servant L M (all British Subjects)
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
In the case of persons proceeding to Russia the age of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Russian Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz.
Assistant British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Education, Physician, Surgeon, Minister of Justice or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address
Recommendations from Banks, Firms should have the printed stamp of the Bank.
