DECLARATION TO BE MADE BY APPLICANT FOR PASSPORT.

I, the Undersigned, (a) Valencia 1<sup>st</sup> May 1912  
(b) Welford Camana of Yousaiah  
residing at Munda Bui Vargus hereby declare that I am

(c) the wife of Welford Camana and that my late husband was  
a (d) British born subject having been born  
at Malta, Miridg on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July 1893

(e) my (his) father has been born within His Majesty's Dominions at  
Malta on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July 1893

and not having lost the status of British Subject thus acquired and I hereby apply for a Passport  
for the purpose of travelling to (f) Salonica (Turkey)

residing at 25 Via Esercizio Valletta hereby declare that to the best  
of my knowledge and belief the above made Declaration of the said Welford  
Camana is true, and that he is a fit and proper person to receive a Passport

(b) Christian Name and Surname of the applicant in full and present address.  
(c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND—not of the applicant herself.  
(d) State whether a British born Subject or a Naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.  
(e) State whether proceeding, and names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) e.g., accompanied by his wife A. and children B. and C. with their Tutor D. E. and a Governess F. G. and Maid Servant H. I. K. and Man Servant L. M. (all British Subjects).  
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.  
In the case of persons proceeding to Abyssinia the age of children should be stated, and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.  
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.  
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz.  
Resident British Merchant Banker Minister of Religion Physician Surgeon Barrister or Shikho (as the case may be) giving professional or business address.  
Recommendations from Bank Chamber should be in the printed stamp of the latter.
