

 In the case of persons proceeding to ADVOY, the ages of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
 (f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be used by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
 (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz.
Resident British Merchant Banker, Minister of Education, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be), giving professional or business address.
 Recommendations from Bankers, Firms should be in the printed stamp of the Bank.
