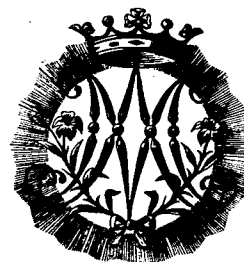

- (d) State whether a **British born Subject** or a **naturalized British Subject** **IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT,**
PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
- (e) State whether proceeding, and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) *e.g., accompanied by*
his wife A, and children B and C, with tutors, D E, and a Governor, F G, and a Maid Servant, H K, and Men
Servant, L M (all British Subjects)
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
In the case of persons proceeding to **RUSSIA**, the ages of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be
mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
- (f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz. —
Resident British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be), giving
professional or business address
- Recommendations from *Banking firms* should bear the printed stamp of the bank
