 (e) State whether proceeding, and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) accompanied by his wife A and children B and C with their Father D E and a Governess F G and Maid Servant H A and Man Servant L M (all British Subjects)  
 The Christian Name and Surname of each person is to be given in full  
 In the case of persons proceeding to RUSSIA the age of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be assumed to be that of the father unless otherwise stated  
 (f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a declaration to be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration  
 (g) Name and Official position of person verifying the Declaration viz  
Resident British Mercantile Officer Minister of the Interior of the City of Leicester  
 (as the case may be) giving professional business address  
 Recommendations from Bankers, etc., should bear the printed stamp of the Bank
