(b) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full and present address.
(c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN or WIDOW the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND or LATE HUSBAND—not of the applicant herself.
(d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.
(e) State whether proceeding and names of persons (to whom accompany if they hold separate passports) accompanied by wife, child or children, and their Tutor, D. L. and G. and Minister of H. K. and Man Sergeant L. M. (all British subjects).
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.
In the case of persons proceeding to his in the ages of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration. Viz. Rev. Ant. British Priest of the Parish of St. Zabbar at St. Zabbar (as the case may be) giving address and full name and address.
Recommendations from Banking Lists should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
