- (c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND—not of the applicant herself.

- (f) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz. Assistant British Consul, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Lawyer, or Solicitor (as the case may be), giving professional or business address. Recommendations from Banks, Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
