EXTRACT FROM ORDINANCE No. III of 1922.

ARTICLE 3. If any person acts in contravention of a direction contained in any regulation made by the Governor under this Ordinance he shall be liable to the punishments laid down for contraventions in the Criminal Laws.

ARTICLE 4. If any person knowingly makes a false statement in any application or recommendation connected with the issue of a passport he shall be liable to be punished with imprisonment, with or without hard labour, for a term not exceeding six months or with a fine (*ukhta*) not exceeding £50 or with both such imprisonment and fine.

ARTICLE 5. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be in addition to those of Ordinance No. XII of 1858.
