Public Registry (Amendments) Bill. (Memo. No. 15)

The Cabinet agreed that a Bill entitled An Act further to amend the Public Registry Act, Chap. 93, be presented to the Legislative Assembly.

The object of the Act was

to simplify the proceedings of registration of notes filed in the Public Registry and to allow a longer period than the present one for the purpose of transcription of such notes in the register.

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Measures for winding up the War Damage Commission (Demo. No. 143)

The Secretary to the Cabinet read an account of the various forms in which claims for compensation under Parts I and II of the War Damage Act had been submitted to the Commission since its inception in 1943 and the methods adopted for the authorisation of payments since then, together with the legislative and other measures which the War Damage Commission thought should be taken with a view to settling all War Damage Claims.
