Licence to Messrs. Cable & Wireless Ltd. to operate in Malta (Memo. No. 94)

The Cabinet again considered the question of the two licences held by Messrs. Cable & Wireless Ltd.; one to operate

Wireless Telegraphy and the other to operate
Telegraphy and Telephony. Both licences expired
on the 31st December, 1962. The Hon. Minister
of Agriculture, Power and Communications read
a letter he had received from the Association
of Scientific Workers on the subject of the
renewal of the licences. It was felt that
the matter needed further study. Meanwhile
the Hon. Minister of Industrial Development
and Tourism undertook to avail himself
of his visit to Rome in October, 1963,
to contact representatives of Stalocable and
ascertain the best conditions under
which the two licences in question could
be renewed.
