An Act to amend the Notarial Profession and Notarial Archives Act, Cap. 92 (Chemo. No. 207)

It was agreed that a Bill entitled an Act to amend the Notarial Profession and Notarial Archives Act, Cap. 92, be taken through its further stages in the Legislative Assembly.

The Bill aimed at removing

the disqualification of women for acting as witnesses or attesters on notarial acts, and the disqualification which excluded women from appointment as notaries.
