on the 28th September, 1964, and was asked to submit the names of persons who would hold office as Chairman and Members of the Broadcasting Authority for the next term. Several names were proposed, among whom Judge Montanaro Jenei, Mr. Giuseppe Pace, Dr. V. Mervica, Mr. Antonio Giteri Mallia were mentioned. The Hon. the Prime Minister was to consider the matter further after he had consulted the Leader of the Opposition in terms of section 121 of the new Constitution of Malta.
