Malta's Relations with NATO. (Memo. No. 397)

Hon. Ministers were
 informed of a letter the Hon. Prime
 Minister had received from the Secretary
 General of the North Atlantic Treaty
 Organization regarding a Resolution which
 NATO proposed to take on the future
 arrangements for Malta.

Tourist Guide Service (Memo. No. 508)

Hon. Ministers agreed to the enactment of legislation providing for the organization and regulation of a tourist guide service in Malta. They approved the draft Bill at Rd 20 C in file and the corrections in ink in paragraph 5 thereof.

Amendments to the Constitution of the International Labour Organisation (Memo. No. 401)

Hon. Members were informed that three Instruments for the Amendments of the International Labour Organisation Constitution were adopted by the International Labour Conference at its 48th Session in 1964. They agreed to the ratification of Instruments of Amendment Nos. 1 and 3 and to the non-ratification of Instruments of Amendment No. 2.

General Authority to Hon. Prime Minister: Registration of Ships in Malta.

The Hon. Prime Minister was given general authority to advise H.E. the Governor-General directly, without the necessity of consulting the Cabinet as a whole, on all matters relating to the registration of ships in Malta.
