Commemorative Stamps

(Mr. A. Ditch and Mr. J. Turek were in attendance)

It was agreed that as a rule there should not be more than four issues of new stamps in each year and that the issues were to commemorate notable events only.

It was further agreed that if it were decided to issue a new set of stamps to commemorate the twenty-fifth anniversary of the award of the George Cross to the Island, all or part of the proceeds from the sale of these stamps should go to the dependents of civilian war casualties who were receiving a pension under the Personal Injuries Scheme.

It was decided that in future the question of the issue of
