Roundtable of British Defence Forces in Malta.

The Cabinet met the Malta Delegation who had been to London to acquaint the British public with the position arising from the decision taken by the British Government to cut down on defence expenditure in Malta. In the light of the views expressed by the Delegation on the outcome of their Mission to the United Kingdom, the Cabinet agreed that a

draft message to the British Government
proposing means of reaching an acceptable
solution to the present problem be prepared.
