Rescission of British Defence Forces in Malta
The Cabinet was informed
of a letter which the Prime Minister had
received from the General Secretary of the
General Workers Union, wherein the
Government was asked to confirm that
in the event of a rejection by the
British Government of the Malta Government's
counter proposals or a collapse of any
eventual negotiations between the two

Government, concerted action by the Government, the Opposition and the General Workers Union would be taken to provide alternative employment to those persons who would be discharged from the Services. It was agreed that the General Workers Union should be informed that in any event the Government would continue to consult the Union with a view to reaching the greatest measure of agreement on measures to be adopted to meet the situation.
