U.K. - Malta Air Services Agreement.

The Cabinet gave further consideration to Memo. No. 619. It was pointed out that other air services agreements with other countries were being held over pending the conclusion of the U.K. agreement. It was agreed that the U.K. Agreements be ratified but that no action be taken before the Hon. Prime Minister and the Hon. Minister of Labour, Employment and Welfare had enquired further into certain aspects of these Agreements and reported back to Cabinet.

Malta Memorial District Nursing Association

Minister of Health by the end of June, 1967, when the matter would again be considered in Cabinet.
