It was agreed that the
immediate problem of housing the new
machinery that was expected in Halle soon

using the site at the Old Parcel Post

It was agreed that the Printing Office
should alternatively be built on the
residual area at Spencer Hill opposite
the Telephone Exchange.

that, in the event of the Department of
Information vacating the premises in
Merchants' Street, the place should be
occupied by the Sas Board and the
present offices of the Sas Board in St. John
Street should be taken over by the Medical
& Health Department.

Use of Unesco's Seal and Emblem (Mem. No. 692)
