Cabinet Meeting held at the Ambasciata d'Argon, Valletta, on Tuesday, 11th April, 1964, at 11 am.

The Cabinet was informed that the Hon. Minister of Trade, Industry and Agriculture had authorized the issue ~~under~~

of a call for tenders under certain conditions (bid 84 in file) for the first extension, Stages II and III, of the Power/Water Station.

Widow's Special Allowance under the National Insurance Act (Memo. No. 446)

The Cabinet considered Memorandum No. 446 and agreed that the National Insurance Act be amended to enable all widows whose husbands were at the time of their death in receipt of old age pension to qualify for a Widow's Special Allowance.

Amendment to the Fees Ordinance (Memo. No. 89)

The Cabinet approved the draft Bill attached to Memorandum No. 89 and agreed that it be passed through all stages in the House of Representatives at an early date. The object of the Bill was to empower any officer representing abroad the interests of the Government of Malta to charge any fees prescribed under the Fees Ordinance.

Implementation of the Security Council's Resolution on Traveling Sanctions (Memo. No. 423)

The Cabinet agreed that the Bill entitled An Act to give effect to a Resolution adopted on the 16th December, 1966, by the Security Council of the United

lations on the question concerning the situation in Southern Rhodesia be passed through the remaining stages in the House of Representatives.

Increase in Wage Scales to Apprentices in Private Industry (Memo. No. 720)

Hon. Ministers were informed of the views of "Finance" and of "Economic Planning" at Rd 4 and minute 6 in file. They agreed to the proposal that the wage scales to apprentices in private industry be increased by 25%.
