Ports Advisory Committee in connection with

the free-port project. It approved a draft letter of intent to Messrs. Redport Co. Ltd. relating to the Company's proposal to establish a free port and a free trade area in Malta (Ref 35 in file), provided that that letter is seen by Prof. Newman, U.N. Expert, and that no substantial changes are recommended.
