Double pay for work performed on Sundays
(The Hon Mr B. Cuschieri, Mr R. A. Chaloner,
and Mr J. Carabott were in attendance)

✓ The Cabinet considered Paper 826
and agreed as follows:-

(a) that, for overtime grades,
compensation for work on Sundays shall be
at double normal time rates for every hour
put in by the employees concerned, subject

to a minimum of half-a-day at double rate.
This will be applicable between 0001 and
2400 hours of the day of Sunday;

(b) that the present system of
allowing Sunday attendance in excess of three
hours to count as a full day shall cease;

(c) that the concession by which
shift workers are allowed an extra day off
when a Public Holiday falls on a Sunday
shall be withdrawn.
