Representation of China in the United Nations

The Cabinet was informed that Italy was again this year proposing to introduce a resolution in the United Nations General Assembly seeking the setting up of a Committee of Member States with the object of studying and reporting on the question of China's representation in the United Nations. It was for decision whether Malta should maintain the stand taken so far, namely, to abstain on the Italian resolution, or to vote for that resolution. It was agreed that

Development of the North West Region of Malta (Memo. No. 613)

The Cabinet considered again the development of the North West Region of Malta and agreed that only in the areas mentioned below should development projects in accordance with approved plans, be allowed:

Campbell Battery, Bardijs Ridge and other selected areas at Bardijs and San Martin.

It was agreed also that no development projects should be allowed for the present in areas known as Jebel Sherzara and Tal Milord at St. Bidnija.

OPM. 1090/67. En Route Charges due by certain Airlines.

The Cabinet considered the question of en route charges which were still due by certain airlines.

It was agreed that traffic rights be given to Alitalia for the flight due to take place on the 7th December 1967 from Malta to Sydney, and that those rights be withheld as from 1st January 1968 for flights performed by Alitalia and other Airlines unless they paid all amounts due by that date.
