Cabinet meeting held at the Auberge d'Angon,
Valletta, on Thursday, 30th November, 1964, at 11 am.

0104. 911/66. Amendments to the Commercial Partnerships
Advances (Memo. No. 494).

Reference was made to
the decision taken in Cabinet on the
30th November, 1964, on the above subject.
It was agreed that the matter be
considered further before action was taken
to effect the recommended amendments to the
Advances.

CPM. 903/64.

Restaurant and Club House at Bawra Road, Lohia (Memo. No. 805)

(Mr. S. Mangin was in attendance)

The Cabinet agreed to the proposed construction of a restaurant and Club House provided the building be not more than one storey in height and no part of the foreshore is included in the plan.

CPM. 913/64.

Development of a site adjacent to Salmon Palace Hotel (Memo. No. 813)

(Mr. S. Mangin was in attendance)

The Cabinet agreed that no development should be allowed on the site adjacent to Salmon Palace Hotel.

CPM. 1509/64.

Development of a site at Haresklokk (Memo. No. 814).

(Mr. S. Mangin was in attendance)

The Cabinet agreed to the development of a site at Haresklokk provided the building be not more than two storeys in height and the elevation be constructed of stone.

CPM. 914/64.

Building of a Hotel at "Il Rajjib" limits of Mellieha (Memo. No. 815)

(Mr. S. Mangin was in attendance)

The Cabinet considered Memorandum No. 815 and agreed that development should be allowed only on the

site marked X on plan - known as "Il-fugji".

In this connection it was agreed also that Government-owned land was in future to be given out for development by tender under certain specified conditions to be drawn up by a Committee set up for the purpose, and composed of representatives of the Public Works Department, the Department of Lands, the Malta Landlord Board and the Finance Department.

CPM. 1587/64 Development of a plot of land at
Mellieha (Mem. No. 886)

(Mr. S. Magro was in attendance)

The Cabinet considered Memorandum No. 886 and agreed to the erection of a hotel only, provided it was completely replanned and sited well away from the coastline. When that was done the project was to be referred back to Cabinet for approval.

Lord 1124/64 Construction of a hotel and several chalets
at Għajnsielem (Overseas Development Company).

(Mr. S. Magro was in attendance)

It was agreed that the project which included the building of ^{four} hotels and several chalets at Għajnsielem, Għajnsielem, be considered further at another meeting of the Cabinet.

CMY. 1299/64. Building of a Hotel at St. George's,
Paceville (Memo. No. 884)

(Mr. S. Mangin was in attendance)

The Cabinet agreed to the erection of a hotel at St. George's, Paceville, provided the building did not exceed five storeys in height and the elevation be constructed of stone.

CMY. 1579/64. Building of a Hotel at Lower Road, Florina,
(Memo. No. 884)

(Mr. S. Mangin was in attendance)

The Cabinet wished to have the elevations of the area where the hotel was proposed to be built, before it considered memorandum No. 884.

CMY. 1589/64. Building of a Hotel at Shajin Liffieja
(Memo. No. 888) (Mr. S. Mangin was in attendance)

The Cabinet did not approve the building of the hotel under the Riviera Hotel at Shajin Liffieja, as originally proposed. Further consideration of memorandum No. 888 would be given if and when a visiting of the hotel was agreed upon.

CMY. 1588/64. Building of a Restaurant and Flats at
St. George's Bay, Birgelmugia (Memo. No. 889)
(Mr. S. Mangin was in attendance)

The Cabinet considered

Demandum No. 889 and agreed that the Chapel and the building around, which had a distinctive character, should not be demolished. The Council would, however, consider new plans for the development of that area behind the Chapel and the House, between Ballotta Road and Zgħira Road.

044. 7/12/66. Development of lands at La' Cini, Sgħ.

(Demos. No. 831)

(Mr. S. Dargatzis was in attendance).

The Council considered Demandum No. 831 and approved the development scheme for La' Cini, Sgħ, with the elimination of the two rows of villas nearest the cliff edge and shown numbered 29 to 78 inclusive on the Company's plan.
