Rental value of a site at Sliema Bay for

Exports Rebate (Memo. No. 898)

(Mr. A. Booth, Mr. M. Abela and Mr. R. Chelmon were in attendance)

The Cabinet considered Memorandum No. 898 regarding the introduction of an export rebate. Owing to the divergent views expressed by the Secretary, Ministry of Trade, Industry and Agriculture, and the Principal Assistant Secretary (Economic Planning), it was agreed that those two officials together with the Secretary, Ministry of Finance, Customs and Ports, should study the matter further and ~~soon~~ submit to the Cabinet a joint report on how best the Government could give assistance to industrialists under the conditions obtaining at present in Malta.
