Reference was made to the decision taken in Cabinet on the 3rd June, 1964, (Sitting No. 54/64) on the Letter of Intent to Messrs. Harport Co. Ltd., regarding the Company's proposals to establish a free port and a free trade area in Malta. A fresh draft of the letter of intent (Red in file) was produced, which the Cabinet approved on the understanding that in the course of negotiations with the Company certain difficulties connected with the handling of cargo, warehousing and attraction of industries would be kept well in mind.
