Reference was made to a
letter received from Messrs. Dent, Allcraft &
Co. of Plymouth, Devon, wherein it was stated
that the condition to train a Maltese
understudy to their General Manager in
the post of A.W. Speckley, was unacceptable

as it would cost between £12,000 and £15,000 to train a Maltese man to gain sufficient knowledge and experience in the various departments. The Cabinet agreed that it would not insist on the training of a Maltese understudy to the General Manager of the Company in Malta if it was felt that that was an impracticable proposition. It was stressed, however, that it remained Government policy to see that wherever possible adequate training is given to Maltese citizens to enable them to reach top or any other level of management.
