OPM. 373/57. Grant of Government-owned site to the S&S
Board for the erection of a S&S Holder.
(Demo. 541)

The Cabinet was informed
that the S&S Board had applied for a site
at Kew, "Il Kungurja", for the purpose
of erecting a S&S Holder. The site
measured 3115 square metres and was then

coloured red on plan (Red 50 B in file).

It was agreed (i) that the site in question be granted to the Sas Board on a 50-year emphyteusis; and (ii) that a reduced rent of two-thirds the fair rental value of the site be charged.

Malta Dockyard.
