## Training of U.S. Armed Forces in Malta.

Minutes 80 and 81 were

read out. Ministers agreed that the request for an "Administrative Landing" by a battalion of the U.S. Sixth Fleet in Malta in June be allowed, subject to the usual conditions and to those mentioned in Reso 77 and 78.

Meanwhile, government was to consider and decide on its future policy of allowing NATO powers to use facilities in Malta.
