Acquisition of land in Malta by non-Maltese
(Memo. No. 1223)

It was agreed that Memorandum No. 1223 be considered further at another meeting of the Cabinet when the Crown Advocate General would be present.

Conference in Malta of ~~International~~ Powers
on Maritime Questions (Memo. No. 1362)

Ministers considered Memorandum No. 1362 and agreed to the holding in Malta of the Conference of Mediterranean Powers on Maritime questions, including the Sea Bed, in 1970, but not during the month of September as Malta would then be the venue of another Conference.
