 Ministers agreed that H.C. The Governor General be advised to authorize the Director of Civil Aviation as in i) to v) in paragraph 6 of minute (H) in file. They agreed also that other similar applications be considered on their own as they arose.



Salaries (Anomalies) Commission and Revision of Salaries.

(The Administrative Secretary, the Deputy Crown Advocate General and the Principal Assistant Secretary (E) were in attendance)

Ministers discussed matters connected with the terms of reference of the Salaries (Anomalies) Commission ~~and the~~ with special reference to the meeting which the Hon. Prime Minister was having on Friday, 30th day, 1969, with the several Staff Associations on the question of the revision of salaries of employees in the Government Service.

Confirmation of Written Opinion.

The files mentioned hereunder were circulated to Ministers whose written opinion was as follows:

Sic. 384/59. A.G. The Governor General was advised to delegate to the Comptroller of Customs his power to admit the importation into Malta, free of duty, of any gift parcels received by the Save the Children Fund, for distribution among children, when duty on such parcels does not exceed five pounds.

C.P.M. 300/69. It was agreed that Malta should accede to the United Kingdom Nations Convention on the Law of Treaties.



Land 202/69. H.E. the Governor General was advised to sign Declaration for the acquisition of land at Xghajra, limits of Zgħbar, required by the Government for the purpose of road widening.

Land 131/69. H.E. the Governor General was advised to sign Declaration for the acquisition of land at Marsalforn, Sgo, required by the Government for the prolongation of Sher Gwyla Street.

Land 99/69. H.E. the Governor General was advised to sign Declaration for the acquisition of land at Tarsien, required by the Government for the purpose of road widening.

OPM. 326/69. H.E. the Governor General was advised to sanction the mortgage of the M.V. "Medina" whose registered owners were Messrs. Medship Ltd. of 11/11, Strait Street, Valletta, in favour of Barclays Bank D.C.O., 54, Lombard Street, London, E.C.3.
