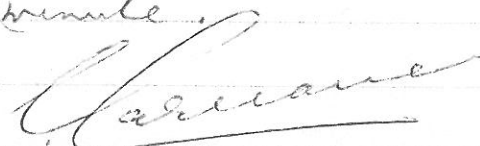
Ministers considered
