Ministers reconsidered the decision taken in Cabinet on the 7th August, 1969, in the light of certain confidential information received regarding Mr. Dounaev and his partner Mr. Vitali Kobych.

It was agreed that the High Commissioner for Malta in London should be asked to inform the Russian Ambassador to Malta that owing to some embarrassing experience from certain films of Malta taken without their being commissioned by the Malta Government, the Government is not for the moment granting any further permission for filming in Malta.
