OPM. 940/69 The Sewage Problem.

Discussions resumed
consideration of the sewage problem in
Malta and Gozo. They agreed that a
Ministerial Committee should be set up
to find the short and the long ^{term} solutions.

OMY. 534/69. Butterment Levy and Gains Tax in respect of land.
