Cabinet Meeting held at the Auberge d'Orang, Valletta, on Thursday, 30th October, 1969, at 11.00 am.

Relay Station: Deutsche Belle (Memo. No. 13414)
(The Administrative Secretary and the Deputy Crown Advocate General were in attendance).

Ministers considered Memorandum No. 13414 and agreed that the following be substituted for para. 13 on page 4 of the Draft Licence (Annex B):

13. (1) In the erection and operation of the relay station and ancillary installations the Licensee shall engage as many Maltese citizens as may be possible and as will be available and shall for this purpose train the necessary Maltese personnel.

(2) All foreign personnel of the Licensee, engaged in the absence of available competent Maltese personnel, as well as their dependents, shall be allowed unhindered passage to and from Malta and permitted to reside there, and such foreign personnel shall be granted the necessary work permits.
