OPT. 1110/69. Raising of Funds to Finance Malta's Development Programme (Demo. No. 1445)

(The Administrative Secretary, the Secretary, Ministry of Finance, Customs & Ports, the Deputy Consul Advocate General and the Principal Assistant Secretary (Economic Planning) were in attendance.)

Ministers considered Memorandum No. 1445. They deferred further consideration of the matter to another meeting of the Cabinet.

Industrial action by Port Dockers.

(The Comptroller of Customs and the Port Manager were in attendance.)

Ministers were informed of the outcome of the meeting which the Hon. Minister of Labour, Employment and Welfare had just had with the Port and Industries Section of the General Dockers' Union regarding the industrial action which the Section was taking in protest at the decision taken by the Port Manager not to allow roll-on roll-off cargo vessels from berthing at the Quay at Marsa.
