The Minutes of Meeting No. 93/6 were read and confirmed.

Land 250/62. Acquisition of land at Rdum Rxaw, Lemxija Hill, St. Paul's Bay (Memo. No. 1333)
Ministers agreed that the two plots of land in question be acquired in the usual manner, and that they should

not be considered as building sites for valuation purposes.

OPM. 1898/65.

United Nations Day

Ministers considered the request submitted by the United Nations Association of the United States of America for support of a proposal that United Nations Day, October 24th of each year, be proclaimed an international holiday. They agreed that the matter be considered further when the proposal was placed on the agenda of the United Nations General Assembly.

LGO. 2058/45.

Amendments to the Traffic Regulations Ordinance (Chemo. Lo. 1385)

Ministers agreed that the Minister of Justice & Parliamentary Affairs should ask Government Members of Parliament to submit their views on memorandum Lo. 1385 within eight days.

OPM. 806/68.

The Immigration Bill (Demo. Lo. 1415)

Ministers considered memorandum Lo. 1415 and agreed that the Bill, as shown in draft at Ref. 396 in file, be brought before the House of Representatives.

CAG. 282/68.

Mandatory Standards: Quality Control (Exports, Imports and Local Goods). Feb. 1969.

Refs 16 and 20 in file were read out. ~~It was~~ It was agreed that foods and drugs should be under the jurisdiction of the Malta Board of Standards provided that a section be inserted in the Bill making it clear that the provisions of the Act shall apply to any food or drug after consultation with the Council of Health.
