Salaries of Judges and Magistrates

Ministers considered the question of the adjustment in the salaries of Judges and Magistrates following the implementation of the recommendations of the Salaries (Anomalies) Commission and agreed that the following revised rates (inclusive of the 4% and 6% increases) be paid from 1st October 1969:-

Chief Justice	£3,800	via	£4,300
Vice-President of the Constitutional Court	3,400	"	2,160
Judges	2,000	"	1,690
Magistrates	2,340	"	1,600

The question of the payment of arrears

prior to that date was to be considered late.

Release of goods from Customs verandahs

Ministers agreed that, as a further measure to ease congestion in the Port, the release of goods from the verandahs should, as an interim measure, start one hour earlier in the morning, i.e. at 7 o'clock and that a disturbance allowance of 10/- a day be paid to the Customs Office concerned in respect of the extra attendance.
