O.P.N. 1127/58 Computation of pension of magistrates

Ministers agreed that the pension regulations be amended to provide for the computation of the pension of magistrates on the basis of $1/360$ of salary in respect of each complete month's service, instead of $1/450$ as at present.

O.P.N. 894/68 Treaty on the non-proliferation of nuclear weapons

Ministers considered memo. no. 1111A and agreed that the Treaty on the proliferation of nuclear weapons signed by Malta in April 1969 should be ratified.

Ministers agreed that His Excellency the Governor General be advised to grant permission to Mr. S. Gatt, ex-Director of Education, to

be a member of the board of Directors of the new Catholic Journal, il-Hajja.
