Ministers considered the situation arising of the industrial action resorted to by the General Workers' Union and the Malta Government Clerical Union and agreed to consider the matter further after the debate to be held in Parliament on the subject on the 15<sup>th</sup> April, 1970. It was also agreed that Establishments, jointly with the legal officers, should consider whether the Government would be justified in withholding the pay of those members of the service who, while on duty, were declining to perform their usual duties.
