Order 528/59/II A amalgamation of Bus Routes

Ministers considered the question of the amalgamation of bus routes and agreed that amalgamation into five groups as recommended by the Traffic Control Board be now proceeded with. It was also agreed that at some reasonable time after amalgamation consideration would be given to any request for a revision of any of the four for individual routes where that was found to be justified. A Press Release announcing these decisions should be issued in which opportunity should be taken to remind bus routes that bus licences were liable to be ~~suspended~~ suspended if the service was not carried out to the satisfaction of the Commissioner of Police.
