OPM 520/69 Oil Exploration and Production Licences

Ministers considered Ref 26 in OPM 520/69 from Malta's Permanent Representative to the United Nations relative to the Cabinet decision taken on the 2nd July, 1970, to include the Medina Bank in the areas to be offered for production licences. In view of Mr. Parde's representations it was agreed that the Medina Bank should not now be included.

OPM 1180/69 Allocation of Fishermen's Stores at Mgarr, Gzira

Ministers considered Memorandum no. 1536 and agreed that the proposal made by the Minister of Trade, Industry and Agriculture, to appoint a Board to make recommendations with regard to the allocation of these stores be acted upon.
