Supply of diesel oil during strike action by the G.W.U.

Ministers were informed that the General Secretary, General Workers' Union had notified the Administrative Secretary to the effect that unless the Police were withdrawn before 12.30 pm that day from the work of delivering petrol and diesel oil supplies to the roadside pumps, industrial action by the Union would be extended to other vital areas.

It was agreed that the existing arrangements should not be disturbed.
